LIMA'S CITY TOUR

ANCESTRAL LIMA: We start our tour with a panoramic view of the “Pucllana Pyramid” a magnificent ceremonial and archeological center built in the 4th century a.D. and considered a “sacred village” by the Incas. The Viceroyalty of Perú was the most important of the Spanish Empire and Lima was its capital

COLONIAL LIMA: We visit the Historical Center of Lima, where you will appreciate more than fifty monuments and Colonial edifications, such as the Paseo de la República, the San Martín Square, the Main Square, the Government Palace, the Archbishop’s Palace, the Cathedral Basilica, and the City Council Palace amongst others.

We will visit the **MUSEUM OF THE BANCO CENTRAL DE RESERVA***, where we will admire the “Treasures of Perú” Collection, a fine selection of objects made of gold, ceramics and textiles from different pre-columbian cultures.

We will visit the monumental **SAN FRANCISCO CONVENT**, which displays the largest collection of religious art in America. Our highlight will be the visit of the underground vaults, known as “Catacumbas” or Catacombs

LARCO MUSEUM

The museum features the finest gold and silver collection from Ancient Peru and a famous erotic archaeological collection

PACHACAMAC RUINS

Pachacamac; was a very important oracle in the Inkas time, the name is Inka/Quechua and means "Hearth's Creator". Everybody wanted to come to Pachacamac to visit and say thank you to the creator. Pachacamac was also the place of Human sacrifices and payments to the mother heart; natives celebrated large festivities in honor to the gods.

Scientists; recommended to visit Pachacamac first, as an introduction to the Inka culture and before go to Cusco and Machupicchu. then you will understand better the Inka traditions, engineering and religion.

objetos y joyas de orfebrería de incalculable valor, trabajadas en oro, plata y piedras preciosas, destacando los ornamentos y objetos que en su época de esplendor utilizaron los Incas, hijos del Dios Sol y monarcas del vasto Imperio Incaico. La fama del oro del Perú atrajo a numerosos aventureros europeos 500 años atrás y fue causa del fin del imperio de los Incas, dando origen al Virreinato del Perú de la Corona Española.

El Museo Oro del Perú, exhibe además una valiosa colección de armas antiguas y modernas que se consideran una de las mejores de su género a nivel mundial. En estas salas se muestran armaduras, uniformes y objetos de diversos tiempos y lugares, incluso algunos datan de 1,300 años A.C. A esta muestra se la conoce como Museo de Armas del Mundo.
